



Retail Price List June 2024 – April 2025

We have kept this document simple and just listed our trees by name rather than including descriptions which can be viewed online on our web site.

We do some grafting ourselves and have another grafter in the UK who has done some for us but most come from Europe due to lack of scion wood and time and experience, walnuts are one of the most difficult hardwoods to graft successfully. These small specialist suppliers in the Netherlands graft *Carya* and *Juglans* amongst other fruits and nuts and have the largest collection of rare and unusual cultivated *Juglandacea* in Europe I would think. The commercial orchard varieties from France, USA etc mostly come from Bulgaria and are very robust Bare-Rooted trees lifted early in the winter to join trees we've grown on here.

Trees are grafted annually in January-May in northern Europe however in warmer climates they can be field bud grafted in summer so the commercial bare-root cultivars are often a year older (16-17m from grafting), hence their size when we receive them.

Many of the cultivated walnut species trees are bare-rooted where we are able but some will be pot grown, usually in 3-7L pots, older trees could be in larger pots. Bare-root plants will be lifted when dormant, probably the end of November.

All the *Carya* cultivars which are grown in pots (they do not transplant well!) with new trees available in September we hope. We have a large number of Pecan cultivars this year along with some hickories and Hicans, it is likely the *Carya* will be in short supply next year.

New Cultivars and Red Kernels

Over the last 8 years I've sourced as many cultivars as I can that were of potential interest for either commercial orchards or unusual nuts.

That includes cultivated forms of the other walnut species and Red Kernelled walnuts of which we've tried about 18 here and grow 15 currently, although there are a good number more out there. Red nuts almost all bud break early in March or at least by Wk1 of April apart from a few notable exceptions, Kardinal and Purpurovy (and maybe Red Moravian).

Our micro-climate here means we experience late spring frosts most years so often the red ones get frosted, this year they all escaped but we think in the future the two cultivars mentioned will be the most successful, to that end we'll continue to supply those when we can, other cultivars once sold will be special order only.

We have a largest selection of Heartnuts this year we've ever had, some new to us and all quite difficult to source every year, the same with the black walnuts (1 new one) and butternuts, I have a few more in the pipeline for the future but it's only ever very small quantities until our trees get larger.

Of the new English walnuts we have enough of A118, Fertignac, Jupanesti, Milotai 10 and Tiszacsécsi 83 to sell some, Fertignac in particular could be thought of as a commercial option we think and we have a good number grafted in the UK.

This year we have sourced other very late pollinating cultivars to trial here and hope to be able to release a few in the future as we think they will be beneficial in our climate where flowering times are more variable.

We also have a small quantity of Jupiter and Mars this year which have proved to be reliable here and have good sized crackable nuts with good flavour, Mars also seems to pollinate quite late some years. Both also did well in the drought of 2022.

Collection and Delivery

Local collection (CV36 5AR) by appointment (Tom Tame 07816 674854) is our preferred option as there is no chance of any damage or loss in transit, we also save the packaging (and the planet) and we get to meet others interested in walnuts! We can also deliver locally if required at 50p per mile within 20 miles, further afield for large quantities.

We offer a 5% discount for collection of 5 or more trees

This is now the only option for the larger bare-root cultivars sold in the winter or anything over 1m tall.

We offer a mail order service for **smaller trees only** (Max parcel of 1.2m in length) but parcel companies willing to take trees are diminishing rapidly.

Next day from £13.00

Delivery to UK non-mainland & NI is no longer available.

Any damage to a parcel must be notified on the delivery ticket and if possible a photo taken at the same time. Trees should be unpacked and watered the same day, we don't send them dry, but they will appreciate the drink.
